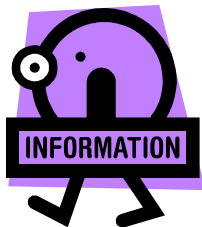
Fulton Avenue Entrance Reopens on September 2

On Tuesday, September 2, the main Fulton Avenue entrance will reopen for vehicle and pedestrian traffic. ***Metered parking for visitors will be available in a small lot to the north of the roundabout,*** and the ***faculty and staff parking lot entrances to College Road North and South will be open.*** The entrance was temporarily closed this summer, while the area was being renovated. Certain areas will still be fenced off for landscaping that will be completed in the coming months.



Free Campus Shuttle for Students from September 2-18

From September 2-18, there will be a free campus shuttle to help students parking in Parking Lots E, F, and G. The shuttle will only run ***Monday-Thursday*** in the ***mornings from 7 a.m.-1:30 p.m.*** and in the ***evenings from 5:45-10:30 p.m.*** Shuttle Stops will be located in Parking Lot E, Parking Lot F, Parking Lot G, Campus South (north of Business Journalism), Campus Center (west of the Campus Center), and Campus North (southeast of the Art Building). Temporarily Relocated Offices to Move into New Locations

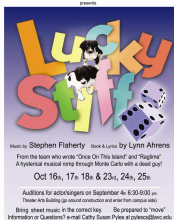

The following is a list of where those offices will be located at: **Assessment Center** in CSIT 2, **English Department** in Humanities 121H, **Math Department** in Math Science 104, **Math Lab** in Math Science 106, **Nursing & Respiratory Therapy Department** in Allied Health and Sciences Center, **Speech Department** in Humanities 108C, and the **Writing Center** in Humanities 100. During the summer, those offices were temporarily relocated due to building renovations and new construction.



Filing Period for Advancement in Academic Rank

Attention all faculty! The filing period for advancement in academic rank for Spring 2009 will **begin on Tuesday, September 2 at 9 a.m. and conclude on Friday, October 10 at 12 noon.** The applications will be available from Tuesday, September 2 at 9 a.m. through Friday, September 26 at 12 noon; Applications are not available online. **The deadline to submit an application for advancement in rank will be Friday, October 10 at 12 noon.** Applicants must inquire into this process on an individual basis; Group or department requests will not be honored. The necessary forms, including a letter of instruction, will be forwarded to the applicant upon request. PLEASE ANNOUNCE TO ALL STUDENTS:

- **Free Parking for LAVC Students from September 2-8.** No parking permits are required to park in all student lots (Parking Lot A, B, C, D, E, F & G) during the first week of the semester (September 2-8, 2008). Vehicles must be legally parked, or they will be ticketed. Student parking permits will be required starting Tuesday, September 9. Don't forget to purchase your parking permit from the Business Office.
- **Free Campus Shuttle from Parking Lot E, F and G.** From September 2-18, there will be a free campus shuttle to help students come onto campus from Parking Lots E, F and G. The shuttle will run Monday-Thursday from 7 am-1:30 pm and 5:45-10:30 pm. More detailed information will be available at www.lavc.edu.
- **DSPS Drop-Off/Pick-Up Zones.** Starting September 2, students with disabilities can now be dropped off at two locations on campus: Fulton Avenue main entrance near the Administration Building, or to the west of the Field House on Ethel Avenue. - **Non-resident Tuition Waiver Policy.** Starting in the Fall 2008 semester, all non-resident students enrolled in *4 or fewer units* will be exempt from paying non-resident tuition. All non-resident students enrolled in more than 4 units will pay non-resident tuition for all units in which they are enrolled.
