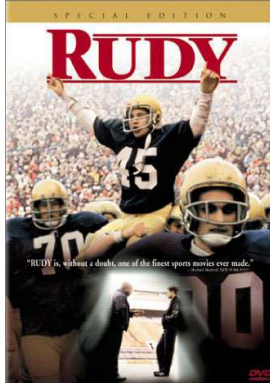

Two LAVC Alums Receive TAP Scholarship to UCLA

Former LAVC Transfer Alliance Program (TAP) students Issam Saab and Rahul Ajit Singh, who have both transferred to UCLA, have been selected to receive a TAP scholarship. Issam will receive the Wasserman TAP Scholars scholarship, and Rahul will receive the Berkman TAP Scholars scholarship. As two of the 27 students were selected to be TAP Scholars, they will be eligible for an academic scholarship of at least \$5,000 per year with an option to renew for a second year by meeting certain requirements. This year, LAVC TAP received the most TAP scholarship recipients among the nine colleges in the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD). Congratulations!

In the past year, the LAVC campus has collected more recycled materials than all nine colleges in the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD). According to figures released by Recycling Strategies, reveals that **since June 2008, LAVC has collected more than 65 tons of recycling**. \$1,000 Mini-grants Awarded to LAVC Instructors

The LAVC Virtual Valley and Technology Training Program, with funding through the Title V Grant, was able to award 23 \$1,000 grants to instructors to create special media content for online, hybrid, or face-to-face courses. A sample of projects being funded include: creating instructional videos for Anthropology, Math, Speech, Music, English and Theater, developing simulations for early California History and CAOT (Computer Applications and Office Technologies) skills, developing materials for synchronous Illuminate sessions with students, and developing podcasts for English, CAOT, Counseling and Media Arts.
