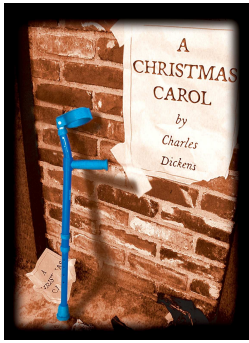
Don't Miss the Sustainability Workshop on December 7th!
