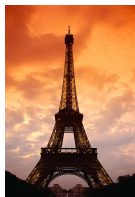
LAVC Theater Arts Department presents *A Christmas Carol*

Vaccines will be given on a first come, first serve basis. Supply is limited. After December 6, flu vaccines will be given to faculty and staff by appointment only. Contact the Student Health Center at (818) 947-2918 to schedule an appointment.

Online "Safety Marshal Training" through Etudes is available to all LAVC faculty and staff. This online course will familiarize participants with the role of a campus safety marshal, whose primary purpose is to evacuate and preserve life after a major emergency, as outlined in the LAVC Emergency Response Plan. Trainees will learn emergency response requirements, develop the ability to respond and assist the campus during a second- or third-level disaster, and learn how to evacuate and secure buildings which may be unstable as a result of the emergency. The course will also provide an overview of the Emergency Operations Plan, how the Emergency Operations Center functions within the plan, and some basic first aid training.
